On 14 and 15 November 2018, the 4th international Growth in Transition Conference, "Europe's Transformation: Where People Matter", takes place in the context of Austria's Presidency of the Council of the European Union. The conference focuses on exploring economic and social pathways toward proactive approaches and the vision of a society that improves the wellbeing of its citizens. Speakers from the social and environmental sectors together with others from academia, economics and politics will join some 700 conference participants at the Austria Center in Vienna. The theme of this year's Conference is the implementation of sustainable development goals (SDGs) and the Paris Agreement. The Conference will be opened by Ban Ki-moon, the former General Secretary of the United Nations and current President and Chair of the Council of the Global Green Growth Institute (GGGI)

Austria's Minister for Sustainability and Tourism, Elisabeth Köstinger, Dutch Minister for Infrastructure and Water Management, Stientje van Veldhoven, French Secretary of State to the Minister for Ecological and Inclusive Transition, Brune Poirson, the first Vice President of the European Commission, Frans Timmermans and Wolfgang Burtscher, Deputy Director-General of the European Commission's Directorate-General for Research and Innovation, will set out their positions and goals at the conference. Other speakers include Kate Raworth, British economist and sustainability expert, Tim Jackson, Professor of Sustainable Development at the University of Surrey and the author of "Prosperity without Growth", Brenda King, former President of the Sustainable Development Observatory, innovation researcher Emma Dewberry, Hans Bruyninckx, Executive Director of the European Environment Agency, Michaela Moser, social scientist and expert on poverty, Christoph Badelt, Director of the European Institute for Economic Research, and Willibald Cernko, Chief Risk Officer at Erste Group.
